

# Welcome to the Murmansk Region!

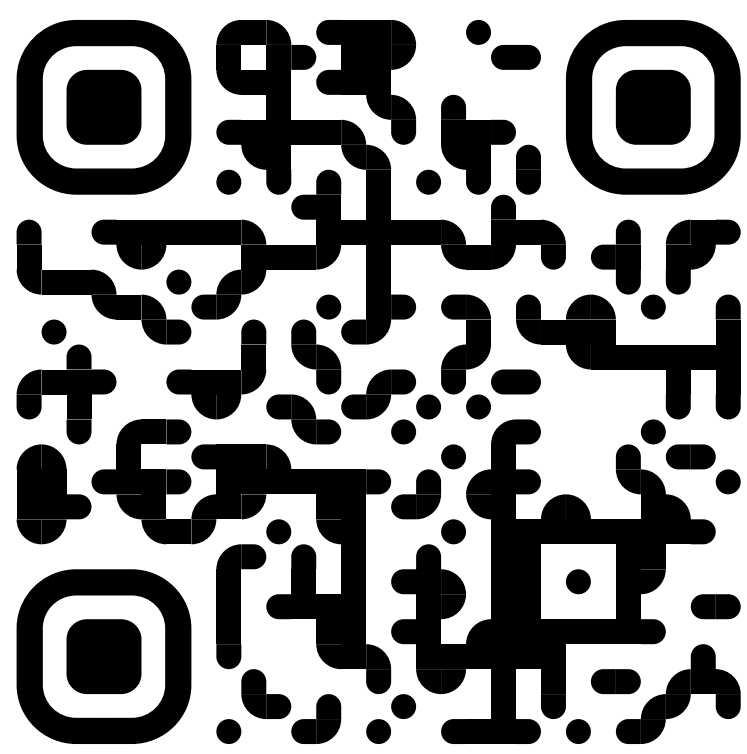
You must get a permit and pay to visit special protected natural areas of regional significance in the Murmansk region.

The cost of visiting of:

- Teriberka Nature Park is **880** rubles
- Rybachy and Sredny Peninsulas Nature Park is **740** rubles
- Sejdjavvr Nature Park is **740** rubles
- Korablekk Nature Park is **440** rubles
- Varzugsky Nature Reserve is **580** rubles
- Kaita Nature Reserve is **300** rubles
- Kolvitsky Nature Reserve is **440** rubles
- Kutsa Nature Reserve is **580** rubles
- Lapland forest Nature Reserve is **440** rubles
- Nizhneponoysky Nature Reserve is **440** rubles
- Ponoysky Zoological Nature Reserve is **200** rubles
- Simbozersky Nature Reserve is **300** rubles

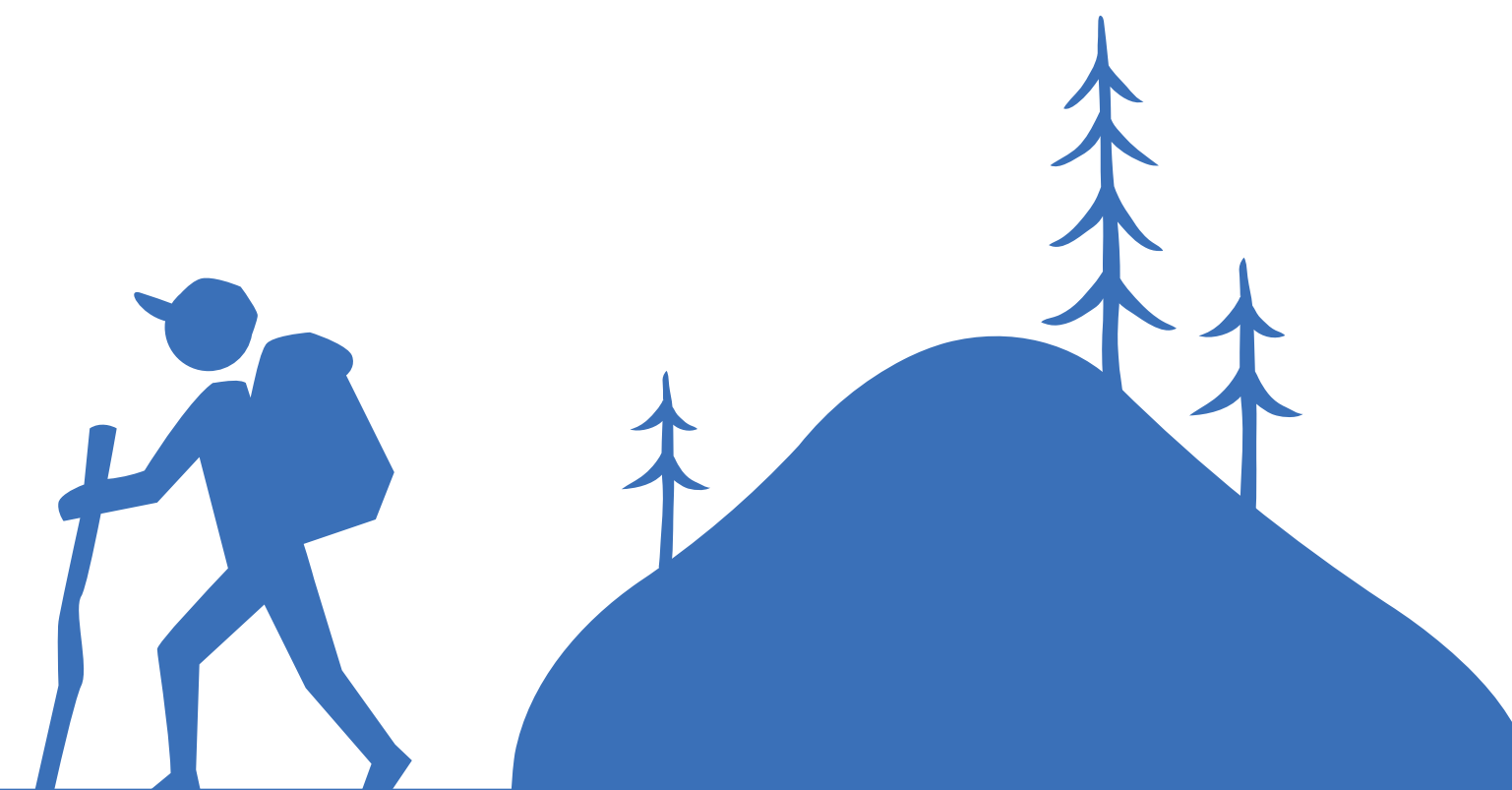

Do not damage the soil covering and do not dig holes



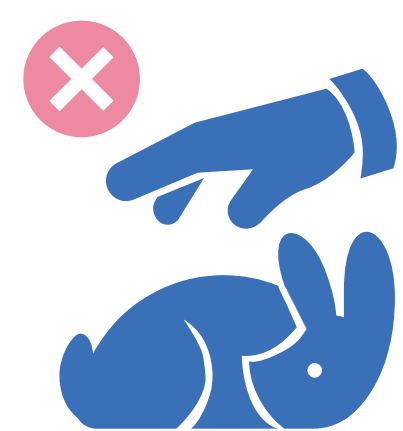
Do not light a bonfire outside of designed areas
